Fianna Fáil Bill sets out pathway to ending variable mortgage rate rip-off – New Ideas required

Cllr Frank O'Rourke has called on Government TD's to support a Fianna Fáil Bill aimed at ending the scandal of banks massively overcharging customers on standard variable mortgage rates. 300,000 mortgage holders nationwide on variable rates are paying hundreds of euro more per month on their mortgage than they should. Fianna Fail did introduce legislation which would have capped the variable rate that banks could charge their customers. The Government rejected this legislation and has to-date not tackled this important issue.
